Facility	Interior: We have experienced leaks in 3 areas of the building. All areas have been patched or sealed at this time.Exterior: Partial tree planting completed in late December with incomplete planting on the front median of the school.An engineer from Duke came out to survey the area and we are currently waiting on a quote for the expense of adding exterior lighting on the street level and surrounding the parking lots. He gave an informal quote of \$500-600 per month.
Compliance:	Nothing is out of compliance in any regards as it relates to SCSA. We recently had our first Exceptional Children's Dept monitoring visit for the year. Two reps from NCDPI came and spent the day observing the EC teacher/coordinator, all files, processes, procedures, etc. We had very high and positive regard from both with recommendations from them in terms of how we are doing things as a first year charter. We have about 3 specific things to correct before our next unspecified visit.
