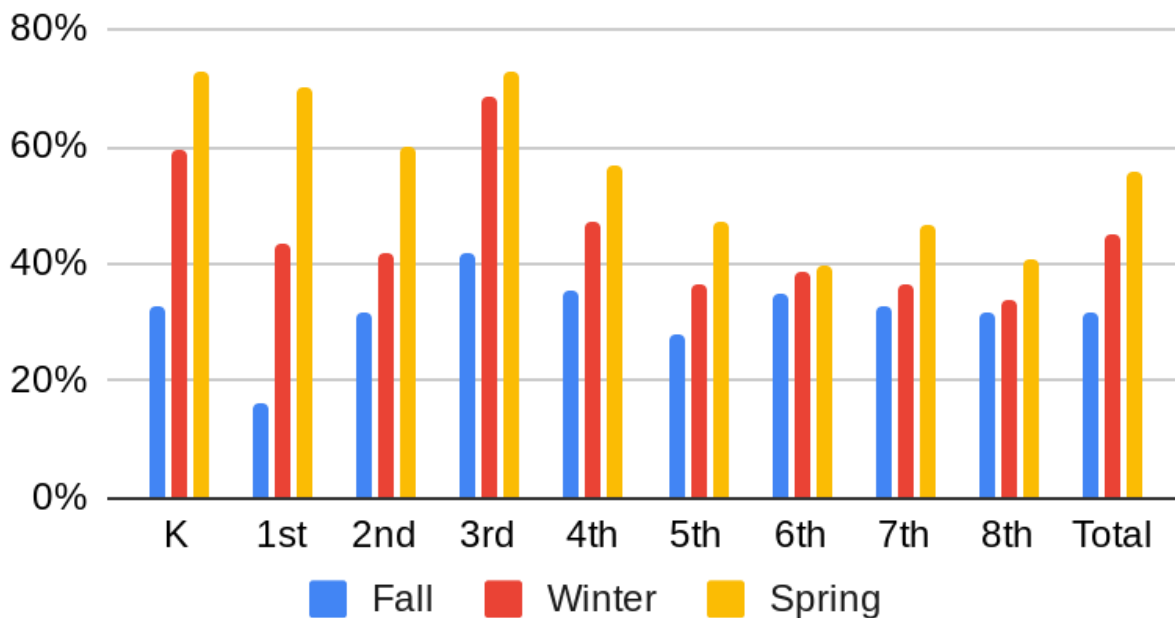

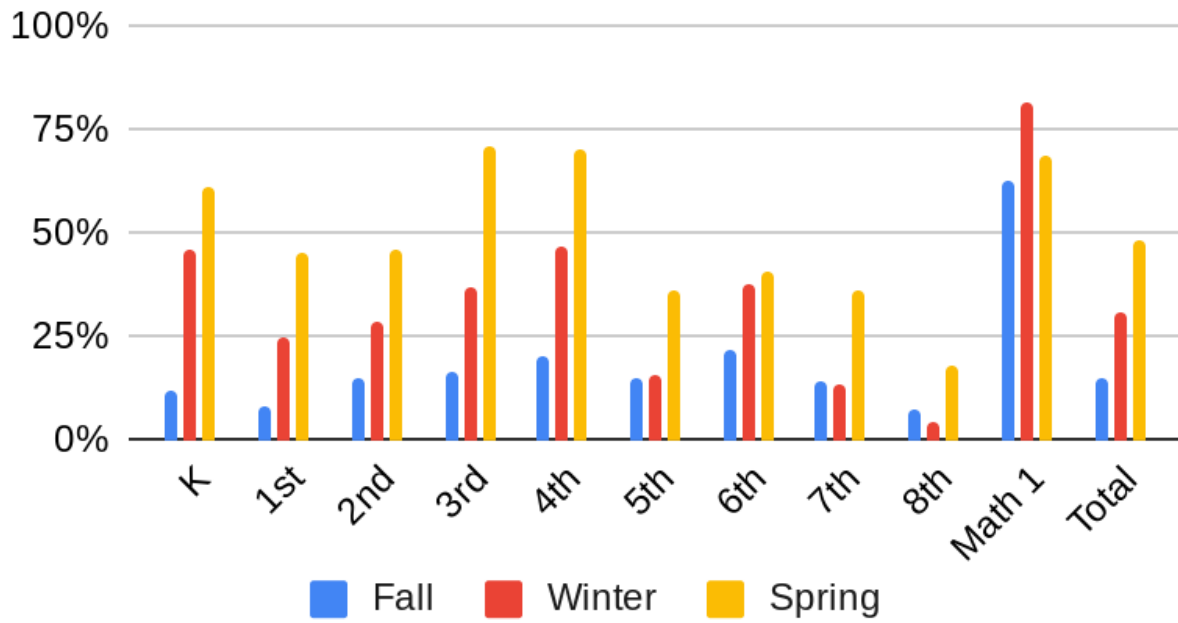

Overall growth based on initial and ongoing benchmark assessments:

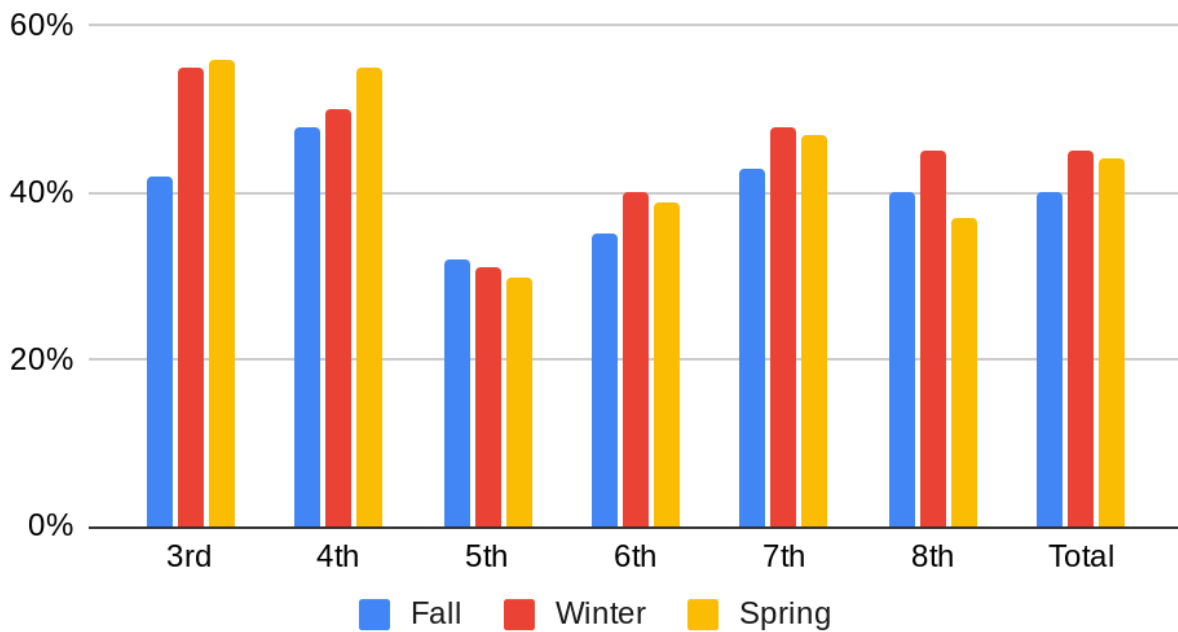
iReady Reading Proficiency Growth



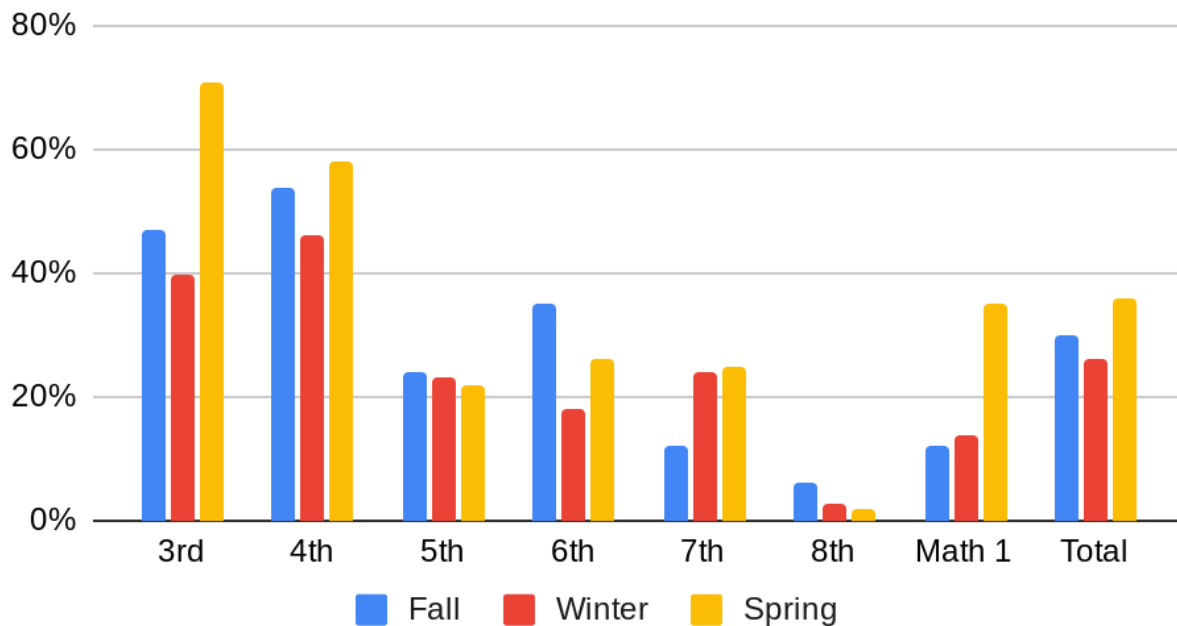
iReady Math Proficiency Growth
