	Bus Transportation: 360 riders daily with a waitlist that is updated every two weeks if a student is no longer riding the bus.
	Food Service: Fully staffed and working to serve free breakfast and lunch daily! 550 lunches daily and now 325 for breakfast!. We've had a slight increase in participation.

Accreditation Process:	SCSA has begun the accreditation process. We have completed the initial candidacy workbook that includes an executive summary, statement of assurances and a diagnostics worksheet to rate the progress of the school in a number of categories. This work was completed by the greater leadership team. Barnes and Lucas have bi-weekly Cognia meetings with the school's facilitator.

Celebrations:

Every classroom in K-4 has a room parent and every grade level in 5-8 has a grade level parent that assists the teachers and teams with tasks, event planning, etc.



We have had a record number of parents come in quarter 1 to volunteer, help teachers with in class events and conference with teachers. This is the most parent engagement and involvement we have had since the school has opened.

Our Girls on the Run (GOTR) group has the largest number of participants and staff members to support since we started in 2019.

We recognized anti-bullying (Unity Day) last week on 10/19 and Breast Cancer Awareness last week with about 85% of student and staff participation.
