	Community Engagement: As previously stated, SCSA partnered with APEX Leadership to not only fundraise, but to help build leadership capacity in all students. To learn more about their program. 	Bus Transportation: 360 riders daily with a waitlist that is updated every two weeks if a student is no longer riding the bus.	
	Food Service: Fully staffed and working to serve free breakfast and lunch daily! 550 lunches daily and now 325 for breakfast!. We've had a slight increase in participation.	
Extracurricular:	Athletics: Both the Volleyball and Soccer teams are the conference champions!!!! This is the 2nd year in a row for both SCSA teams and we are incredibly proud of them and the great coaching staff.

Accreditation Process:	SCSA has begun the accreditation process. We have completed the initial candidacy workbook that includes an executive summary, statement of assurances and a diagnostics worksheet to rate the progress of the school in a number of categories. This work was completed by the greater leadership team. Barnes and Lucas have bi-weekly Cognia meetings with the school's facilitator. We are on schedule to submit most items prior to January.
